

Orion Junior High Honor Society Rules and Bylaws

Application Procedures and Requirements

- 7th and 8th grade students may apply for Honor Society admittance during the first week of 4th quarter. Daily announcements will be made two weeks prior to applications being available. Announcements will also appear in the school newsletter.
- Students must meet the following requirements to apply for Honor Society:
 - A 3.75 GPA average for first, second, and third quarters of the current school year.
 - No N's or U's as citizenship marks.
 - Positive recommendations by all current teachers.
- The committee reviewing the applications will also take into consideration:
 - Essay questions answered by candidate.
 - Reviews by student-chosen adults.
- Applicants will be given notification of Honor Society status by the last week of April.
- All new Honor Society members will be sworn in and welcomed into the Honor Society organization at the Honor Society Induction Ceremony, which is usually held during the first week of May.

Honor Society Participation and Good Standing

To remain in good standing with the Honor Society organization, Honor Society members must meet the following requirements:

- Maintain a 3.5 GPA each quarter.
- Have no N's or U's as citizenship marks.
- Complete at least 2 hours of service in the community. This service should be independent of family, church, and Scouting organizations.

Students who do not meet the above requirements will be put on probation the following quarter. While students are on probation, they may not participate in the Honor Society-sponsored activities. If students fail to meet the requirements a second quarter at Orion Junior High, they will no longer be members of the Honor Society organization.
