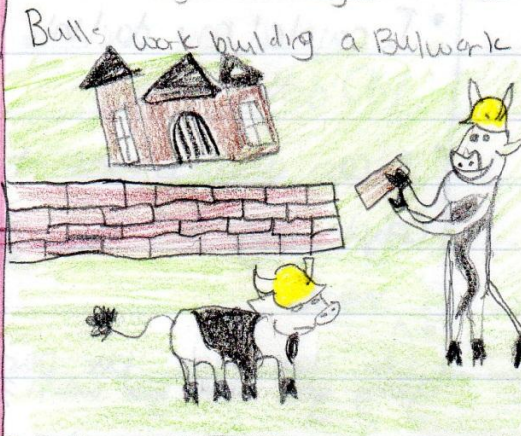

**Bulwark** - (BULL work)n. a defensive wall;  
Something serving as a principal defense



- The great wall of China is like a Bulwark or a defensive wall.
- We built a bulwark or a shield of protection around our fort.
- There is a city that has a wall of defense called a Bulwark.

**Cache** - (KASH)n. a hiding place, or the objects hidden  
in a hiding place Link: Cash



- I have a cache or hiding place for all of my important things.
- Where is your cache or hiding place for your Mt. Dew?
- My dad has a cache or a place where he hides his money.

**Cacophony** - (Kuh Kah Fuhnee)n. harsh sounds Link: Cough

**Fluville** - a cacophony of coughing



- She heard a Cacophony or a lot of harsh sounds at the rock concert.
- In the smokers lounge you probably hear a lot of Cacophony, harsh cough sounds.

• When I was sick my cough sounded Cacophony or harsh.
